A discussion about the lawsuit was held. Plans are to get a motion on file in September regarding our case and to send discovery requests to the farmers/growers of the nine poultry operations we are specifically contesting.

#### 5. Status of Filing Protest against DP

Update from Bill Chambers –after discussion with other attorneys, overall felt body of work did not justify bill. Next steps discussed to remediate overcharge.

#### 7. Gravel Mining Update

Gayle Ross will represent SCC in OKC, Aug 24, 10 am and Beth will attend as well as potentially Travis Fite at Protest hearing.

#### 8. Water Monitoring Update

We have worked out the level of exceedance standards for our Baseline Results (example: 0.01 for phosphorous). Emily Oakley is working on a visual presentation of the 12-month baseline data showing which sites meet or exceed standards. We will be sending our data to the OK DEQ for inclusion in their 2022 Integrated Water Quality Report.

#### 9. Updates, Other

-Newsletter

-Discussed illegal fish harvesting, on Facebook and shared multiple times (should increase awareness).

-Marijuana houses –concern with water usage and contamination

-Update on Stream bank- Oklahoma Conservation Commission coming up with better method and may give up to \$50,000 for bank protection method that is better but more expensive to prevent erosion in specific location on Spring Creek.
